Vermentino Costamolino 2015 Argiolas (Sardegna) <i>founded in 1918 and one of the finest in Sardinia. It's intensely flavoured, yet has subtle elegant flavours and a dry finish which goes well with shellfish</i>	£26.90
Grillo 2015 Branciforti (Sicilia) <i>a clean, citrus wine with a touch of hazelnuts. A well balanced wine, fullness on the palate and then a delicious vibrant finish</i>	£24.90
Pinot Grigio delle Venezie 2015 Zenato (Veneto) <i>great reputation for their Amarone, however their whites made from handpicked grapes near Lake Garda are very concentrated, well defined and a dry finish</i>	£26.90
Orvieto Classico Secco 2015 Marchesi Antinori (Umbria) <i>this persistent wine with a classic almond finish is the most famous white wine in Umbria</i>	£22.90
Sauvignon Blanc Collio 2015 Livon (Friuli-Venezia Giulia) <i>the Livon motto is "quality above all else". The grapes are harvested by hand with hints of green pepper and melon with a crisp dry finish</i>	£28.90
Soave DOC 2015 Tamellini (Veneto) <i>straw yellow colour, flowery and a fruity nose. Intense and fresh on the palate, with a lovely almond note after taste</i>	£28.90
Gavi 2015 Alta Battistina (Piemonte) <i>fresh, dry and lightly aromatic with fruit and crisp mouth watering coolness</i>	£25.90
Pinot Grigio Blush 2015 Le Poesie (Veneto) <i>this elegant and fragrant Pinot Grigio Blush is well balanced, medium bodied, aromatic and deliciously crisp on the palate</i>	£21.50
Pecorino Tullum 2015 Feudo Antico Tollo (Abruzzo) <i>inspirational and monumental in modern quality wine making in Abruzzo. Tollo produces a wine of great complexity in which the floral aromas are elegant and elusive with exceptional depth and length flavours</i>	£29.50
Capichera 2014 Vignangena` (Sardegna) <i>this wine is 100% Vermentino grape. Colour is pale straw yellow with very clear light greenish hues. Fresh, lively fragrant fruit with a lingering finish</i>	£49.50

Nero D' Avola 2013 Chiaramonte (Sicilia) <i>well balanced soft red wine, produced with nero d'avola grapes</i>	£25.90
Salice Salentino 2014 Cantine Due Palme (Puglia) <i>ruby, red wine, light garnet reflections is warm, smooth and lingering on the palate</i>	£22.50
Chianti Classico 2014 Rocca Delle Macie (Toscana) <i>attractive wine with a succulent palate of crushed berry fruits. Medium bodied with a rich, long finish</i>	£23.90
Ripassa Valpolicella Superiore 2012 Zenato (Veneto) <i>closely connected to the great wine of Valpolicella Amarone. After pressing the dried grapes from which Amarone is made the wine is passed over the still warm mark of Amarone. A second alcoholic fermentation begins which increases the alcoholic content and the wine becomes richer in colour and bouquet</i>	£39.90
Vino Nobile di Montepulciano 2013 La Braccasca Antinori (Toscana) <i>intense and typical aromas of fruits, with a delicate hint of vanilla. Well structured and nicely balanced on the palate</i>	£43.50
Pinot Noir 2014 Cantina Terlano (Alto Adice) <i>fresh nose with an aromatic spectrum from blackberry and blueberry and a hint of cherry brandy. Delightful balance between ripe fruit and structure</i>	£35.90
Brunello di Montalcino 2011 Banfi (Toscana) <i>a fantastic vintage which is showing superbly well, very classic rich fruit flavours with subtle undertones of cedar and spice</i>	£58.50
Barolo 2011 Marchesi di Barolo (Piemonte) <i>one of the most prestigious wines in the world. The Nebbiolo grapes gives the wine great body, character and a rich, majestic style</i>	£52.50
Amorone della Valpolicella Classico 2011 Begali Lorenzo (Veneto) <i>a blend of corvine and moynara grapes. Aged for a minimum of 3 years, the result is a rich bouquet, full bodied with very deep fruit flavours</i>	£58.50
Sito Moresco 2013 Angelo Gaja (Piemonte) <i>Nebbiolo, Barbera and Merlot. Warm smokey cooked fruit nose with cherries in it's centre. Soft rich ripe fruit, mouth filling with a velvety big finish</i>	£69.50

The winery was built in the late 1700s in the heart of the Campania region, devoted to viticulture and wine making since Greek and Roman times. They produce exclusively an unlimited amount of wines from the ancient grape varieties of Greek and Latin heritage.

WHITE

Mastro 2014 £21.90
a blend of indigenous grapes from various sites held in the Campania region. Mastro is a fresh wine with good acidity

Lacrimacristi 2015 £25.90
100% Coda di Volpe, straw yellow with hints of pineapple, white peach and a typical liquorice aroma. A well-structured and balanced wine

Falaghina Morabinca 2015 £27.90
100% Falaghina variety. Fresh and fruity, with persistent notes of citrus fruit. A very well-balanced wine with a complex and individual character

Greco di Tufo Novaserra DOCG 2015 £32.50
100% Greco with a prominent peach, apricot bouquet. A palette noted for its smoothness and almond flavoured finish

Fiano di Avellino Radici DOCG 2015 £33.90
fiano grape from S. Stefano del Sole. Straw yellow with aromas of pear, pineapple, acacia, nuts, honey and spring flowers. Excellent acidity, fine smoothness and hints of almond in the finish

Fiano di Avellino Radici Vintage Magnum 2002 £78.00

Lacrimarosa (Rose) 2013 £25.90
this rose keeps the overall fruit of the Aglianico grape, with its bouquet of small red fruits, meanwhile with the same of a white

Aglianico 2013 £29.90
deep ruby red colour, with hints of amarena and wild blackberry. Soft and elegant on the palate

Taurasi Radici 2011 £57.00
from the Aglianico grape. Strong personality with a dense structure and Aromatic concentration. Full-bodied, elegant wine with peppery finish

90% Piediroso and 10% Sciascinoso, aged one year in barriques, it's bouquet is complex full and persistent. One of their most prestigious wine, produced from vines in the Pompei excavations.

Don Manuel Villafane (Argentina)

full transparent yellow colour with an expressive nose of flowers and citric aromas. In the mouth, its fresh and longer bodied than Chardonnay with rich notes of peach and fresh grapes

Chardonnay 2015 £26.90

Cuvee Alexandra (Chile)

intense fruit aromas of sweet citrus fruit, white flowers, fresh tropical fruits and sweet spices. Elegant and concentrated in the mouth with a creamy texture balanced by a crisp citrus edge

Buitenverwachting Sauvignon Blanc 2015 £32.50

Constantia (South Africa)

a pale lemon-colour with a bouquet of figs with hints of gooseberries and green peppers. Dry and full-bodied with a long, lingering finish

Malbec 2015 £25.50

Don Manuel Villafane (Argentina)

the nose is dominated by plums, liquorice, cinnamon, mint, pepper and vanilla. Full, warm and round flavours on the pallet, a persistent vanilla and liquorice flavour on the finish

Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 £27.90

Cuvee Alexandra (Chile)

a ruby red with an intense and complex bouquet blackberries, blackcurrant and plums, mixed with spice and oak. Full-bodied wine which combines elegance and strength with spicy and sweet fruit characters on the finish

Pinotage Merlot 2013 £26.90

Delheim (South Africa)

a supple, succulent wine with mulberry and cherry flavours and a fragrant cigar-box finish. Sophisticated with great balance and length of flavour

Chablis 2014 £28.90

William Fevre

fresh bouquet with notes of citrus and white fleshed fruit. with a very slightly oaky finish. Its fresh and supple

Pouilly Fume` 2014 £29.90

Le Bouchot

a more complex and rounder wine. With subtle flavours and a very long finish

Puligny-Montrachet 2012 £58.00

Louis Latour

neither overly fruity nor over oaked. They are extremely well balanced, emphasising the classic minerality of Puligny-Montrachet

Cloitre des Capucins 2011 £28.90

Antoine Moueix

this classic St. Emillion Grand Cru is very elegant and features aromas of red berries, ripe cherries and toasted vanilla. The wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barrels

Chateau Tour St. Bonnet 2011 £29.90

Cru Bourgeois

This wine is dark purple in colour with aromas of blackcurrant and raspberry. This delicious wine is ripe and juicy with soft tannins. It is a classic wine with a modern twist
