Vermentino I Fiori 2016 Pala (Sardegna) <i>founded in 1918 and one of the finest in Sardinia. It's intensely flavoured, yet has subtle elegant flavours and a dry finish which goes well with shellfish</i>	£28.90
Grillo 2016 Branciforti (Sicilia) <i>a clean, citrus wine with a touch of hazelnuts. A well balanced wine, fullness on the palate and then a delicious vibrant finish</i>	£24.90
Pinot Grigio Valdadige 2016 Santa Margherita (Trentino-Alto-Adige) <i>straw yellow in colour with a clean, crisp fragrance with intense yet elegant hints of quince. Fresh, harmonious fruit set off by slight sweetness with a long finish full of delicate, tangy flavour.</i>	£26.90
Orvieto Classico Secco 2016 Marchesi Antinori (Umbria) <i>it has imposing structure and depth, as much in its aromas of mature fruit and spices. On the palate, the alcohol is sustained by the right degree of acidity</i>	£22.90
Sauvignon Grave 2015 Antonutti (Friuli-Venezia Giulia) <i>luminous straw yellow in colour. The bouquet is true to the typical characteristic of the varietal. Vivacious in the mouth with a strong aromatic persistence</i>	£27.90

Pecorino 2016 Zaccagnini (Abruzzo) <i>Yamada translates from Japanese as "Mountain Field". This wine has a bright yellow colour with greenish tinges. A citrus, aromatic and very pleasant bouquet where grapefruit stands out.</i>	£29.50
Solosole Vermentino 2015 Poggio al Tesoro (Toscana) <i>this straw yellow wine, with intense acacia blossom aromas, yellow plums and subtle grapefruit. Medium bodied, refined palate with refreshing acidity and delicate apricot on the finish</i>	£34.50
Chardonnay Ca' del Bosco 2013 Franciacorta (Lombardia) <i>100% chardonnay. Rich nose with hints of vanilla. Full body, smooth and creamy on the palate with a strong acid backbone. The finish is elegant and silky</i>	£87.50

Salice Salentino 2015 Cantine Due Palme (Puglia) <i>ruby, red wine, light garnet reflections is warm, smooth and lingering on the palate</i>	£22.50
Chianti Classico 2014 Lamole di Lamole (Toscana) <i>attractive wine with a succulent palate of crushed berry fruits. Medium bodied with a rich, long finish</i>	£29.90
Ripassa Valpolicella Superiore 2014 Tedeschi (Veneto) <i>closely connected to the great wine of Valpolicella Amarone. After pressing the dried grapes from which Amarone is made the wine is passed over the still warm mark of Amarone. A second alcoholic fermentation begins which increases the alcoholic content and the wine becomes richer in colour and bouquet</i>	£39.90
Vino Nobile di Montepulciano 2014 La Braccasca Antinori (Toscana) <i>intense and typical aromas of fruits, with a delicate hint of vanilla. Well structured and nicely balanced on the palate</i>	£43.50
Merlot 2013 Tenuta Rovaglia (Lombardia) <i>100% merlot grapes aged in large wooden barrels. In the nose forestry, wild black berries, fine and soft acid, medium with velvety tannins</i>	£31.90
Brunello di Montalcino 2012 Banfi (Toscana) <i>a fantastic vintage which is showing superbly well, very classic rich fruit flavours with subtle undertones of cedar and spice</i>	£58.50
Barolo 2012 Marchesi di Barolo (Piemonte) <i>one of the most prestigious wines in the world. The Nebbiolo grapes gives the wine great body, character and a rich, majestic style</i>	£52.50

Coda di Volpe 2016 £26.90
100% Coda di Volpe, straw yellow with hints of pineapple, white peach and a typical liquorice aroma. A well-structured and balanced wine

Falaghina 2016 £25.90
100% Falaghina variety. Fresh and fruity, with persistent notes of citrus fruit. A very well-balanced wine with a complex and individual character

Greco di Tufo DOCG 2016 £30.90
100% Greco with a prominent peach, apricot bouquet. A palette noted for its smoothness and almond flavoured finish

Fiano di Avellino DOCG 2016 £30.90
fiano grape with aromas of pear, pineapple, acacia, nuts, honey and spring flowers. Excellent acidity, fine smoothness and hints of almond in the finish

Irpinia Rosato (Rose) 2016 £25.50
this rose keeps the overall fruit of the Aglianico grape, with its bouquet of small red fruits, meanwhile with the same of a white

Aglianico 2013 £29.90
deep ruby red colour, with hints of amarena and wild blackberry. Soft and elegant on the palate

Taurasi DOCG 2010 £38.90
from the Aglianico grape. Full bodied with musky berry flowers and firm tannins. Even when grown in hot climates, Aglianico is capable of reaching high levels of acidity

from the Aglianico grape. Strong personality with a dense structure and Aromatic concentration. Full-bodied, elegant wine with peppery finish

Cuvee Alexandra (Chile)

intense fruit aromas of sweet citrus fruit, white flowers, fresh tropical fruits and sweet spices. Elegant and concentrated in the mouth with a creamy texture balanced by a crisp citrus edge

Buitenverwachting Sauvignon Blanc 2015 £32.50

Constantia (South Africa)

a pale lemon-colour with a bouquet of figs with hints of gooseberries and green peppers. Dry and full-bodied with a long, lingering finish

deep red colour with violet highlights. Complex aroma of plums and mature black fruits, liquorice and black pepper. Firm, sweet and mature texture. Round wine, wide in the middle of the mouth, with a long and harmonious finish

a ruby red with an intense and complex bouquet blackberries, blackcurrant and plums, mixed with spice and oak. Full-bodied wine which combines elegance and strength with spicy and sweet fruit characters on the finish
